Please pray for wisdom and discernment as our teachers teach, guide, and support the children of HBC with their faith journey each week.

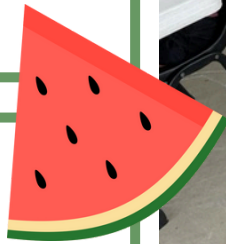


Curriculum Review:
