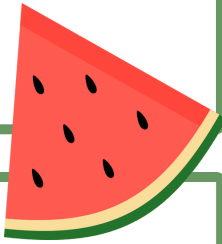
The students:

This season, our young ones having been diving into the “Anchored” Bible Study curriculum during first service.
